

Changes reported by parents since initial Assessment:

- Less processing time
- Less fidgeting, bouncing around
- Can sit in one place and play board games
- Talks more about school – reporting
- Talks more about her feelings
- Better sense of time (past and future)
- More interest in writing her journal
- More interest in writing lists and planning and organizing things
- More facial expressions
- Better control of voice
- More self regulation
- Loves going under water while swimming
- Big improvements in swimming
- Somewhat better with having nails trimmed
- Better comprehension
- More interest in math
- Walks more, gait is firmer
- More interest in the opinions of parents
- Responds when greeted by others
- Reports more, especially when appropriately encouraged
- Large improvements in reading and spelling
- Loves going to school
- Wants to spend more time with family
- Diet choices are narrower
- Pronoun reversals are reduced significantly
